## Project Summary:

The objectives of The Source Partnership are to build up and exchange knowledge on tracking methods, prevention and pre-treatment technologies as well as authority regulations of the wastewater sources. A cornerstone for the future public work in both Denmark and Sweden is the EU Water Framework Directive (WFD). The WFD describes the implementation of the measures necessary to reduce the pollution from priority substances. The project will strengthen the local authorities' preparation of the action plans in this field.
